



THE CLOCKHOUSE STATEMENT OF FAITH

The apostle's creed is thought to include the essential teaching of the 12 apostles, Jesus' earliest followers. It is a summary of the Christian faith, and it was into that faith of the apostles that Christians were, and are, baptized. The apostles were people who bore witness to Jesus, they had met the risen Jesus and were sent to share his message with others. The Apostles Creed

We believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

We believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary.

He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to hell.

On the third day he rose again from the dead, he ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy and universal church, the fellowship of believers, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.
